

INSTRUCTIONS FOR INCOMING STUDENTS

Preschool Teacher Training and Business Informatics College of Applied Studies-Sirmium publishes and regularly updates the course catalogue on the website of the Institution well in advance of the mobility periods, so as to be transparent to all parties and allow mobile students to make well-informed choices about the courses they will follow. It has also developed the linguistic policy for incoming students. Incoming students are offered courses in Serbian, English and Russian. As far as Serbian language is concerned Preschool Teacher Training and Business Informatics College of Applied Studies-Sirmium organizes Intensive Course of Serbian Language and Literature that are held in each semester of each academic year. These courses are planned to provide sufficient linguistic preparation for students as well as to provide necessary information on our culture. These courses are free of charge and at the entire expense of Preschool Teacher Training and Business Informatics College of Applied Studies-Sirmium. The complete program of mobility is realized in accordance with the signed Learning Agreements based on good cooperation practices, compatibility of study programmes. We provide support that refers to pre-arrival and pre-departure arrangements, provide services for students regarding hotel accommodations, visas, insurance or part-time employment. For EU citizens a visa is not necessary to enter Serbia, this can be done with a valid personal ID card. Preschool Teacher Training and Business Informatics College of Applied Studies-Sirmium ensure equal academic treatment and services for incoming mobile participants due to the activities of the team members responsible for technical support for incoming and outcome students. Our teaching staff ensures appropriate mentoring and integrates incoming mobile participants into the Institution's everyday life.
